

If traffic is detoured onto City of Council Bluffs streets, contact CB Public Works (712-3	328-4645) to adjust signal timings
Coordinate with Iowa DOT Maintenance and Highway Helper for traffic control needs; i	ncluding moving arrows on

permanent signing along city streets to reflect active detour

Contact DOT construction to stop hauling activities, if necessary
