Minor Impact to Traffic (Less Than 30 Minutes)

Intermediate Impact to Traffic (30 Minutes to 2 Hours)

Implement Local and Global Detours	
Provide alternate route information to Pottawattamie and Douglas County Emergency Communications to notify emergency responders	
Monitor Critical Intersections along detour route and request LE traffic control, if needed	
If traffic is detoured onto City of Council Bluffs streets, contact CB Public Works (712-328-4645) to adjust signal timings	
Coordinate with Iowa DOT Maintenance and Highway Helper for traffic control needs; including moving arrows on permanent signing along city streets to reflect active detour	
Contact DOT construction to stop hauling activities, if necessary
