

Minor Impact to Traffic (Less Than 30 Minutes)

Intermediate Impact to Traffic (30 Minutes to 2 Hours)

Peak Period -	Diversion not implemented:

Off Period – Shoulder and One Lane Blocked	Deploy informational DMS messaging for approaching traffic
Peak Period – Shoulder and One Lane Blocked	Partial Diversion: On-scene traffic control Deploy informational DMS messaging for approaching traffic Deploy DMS messaging directing through traffic to use diversion routes Monitor local diversion routes at critical locations as needed
All Lanes Blocked	 Full Diversion: On-scene traffic control Deploy DMS messaging directing all traffic to use diversion routes Deploy law enforcement to direct traffic at critical locations

Peak Period – Shoulder and One Lane Blocked	Partial/Discretionary Diversion: Deploy cones, barricades, and other appropriate traffic control devices Deploy informational DMS messaging for approaching traffic Deploy DMS messaging directing through traffic to use diversion routes Divert traffic to local diversion routes at discretion of incident commander
