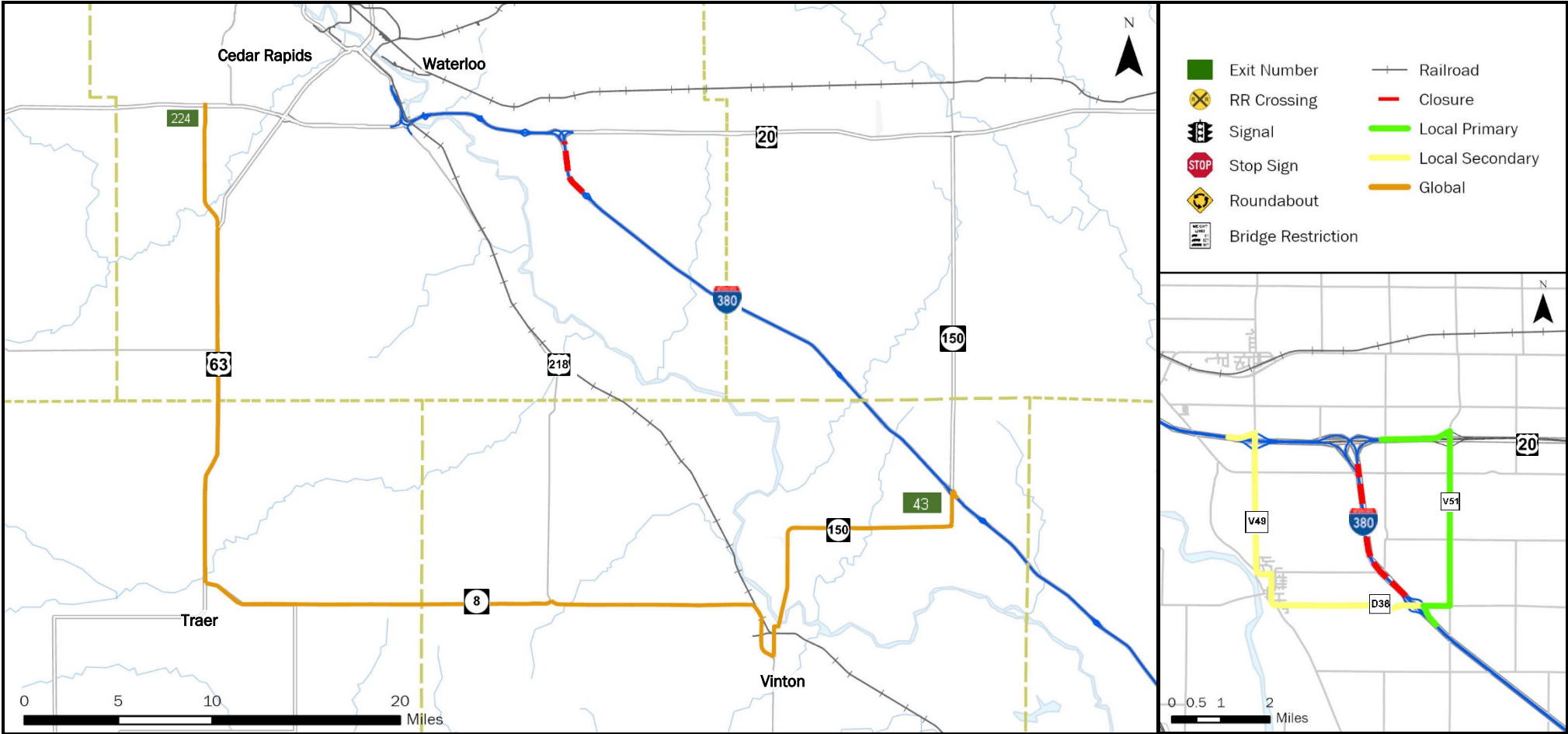

Minor Impact to Traffic (Less Than 30 Minutes)

Off Peak – Shoulder Blocked	Diversion not implemented: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On-scene traffic control • Deploy informational DMS messaging for approaching traffic
Off Peak – Shoulder and One Lane Blocked	

Intermediate Impact to Traffic (30 Minutes to 2 Hours)

Peak Period – Shoulder Blocked	Diversion not implemented: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On-scene traffic control • Deploy informational DMS messaging for approaching traffic
Off Period – Shoulder and One Lane Blocked	
Peak Period – Shoulder and One Lane Blocked	Partial Diversion: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On-scene traffic control • Deploy informational DMS messaging for approaching traffic • Deploy DMS messaging directing through traffic to use global diversion • Monitor local diversion routes at critical locations as needed
All Lanes Blocked	Full Diversion: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On-scene traffic control • Deploy DMS messaging directing all traffic to use diversion routes • Deploy law enforcement to direct traffic at critical locations

Major Impact to Traffic (Greater Than 2 Hours)

Peak Period – Shoulder Blocked	Diversion not implemented: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On-scene traffic control • Deploy informational DMS messaging for approaching traffic
Off Period – Shoulder and One Lane Blocked	
Peak Period – Shoulder and One Lane Blocked	Partial/Discretionary Diversion: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deploy cones, barricades, and other appropriate traffic control devices • Deploy informational DMS messaging for approaching traffic • Deploy DMS messaging directing through traffic to use global diversion • Divert traffic to local diversion routes at discretion of incident commander
All Lanes Blocked	Full Diversion: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deploy cones, barricades, and other appropriate traffic control devices • Deploy DMS messaging directing all traffic to use diversion routes • Deploy law enforcement to direct traffic at critical locations

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RESPONSIBILITIES

Iowa State Patrol Comm. Center	800-525-5555
Dispatch State Patrol. On-Scene Incident Commander: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Secure scene. Notify appropriate communications center of incident location, anticipated duration, affected lanes, and identify the incident commander. Coordinate with the communications center regarding diversion route needs. Minimize impact to traffic through coordination of on-scene traffic control. Ensure overweight vehicles are parked. When the incident is safely cleared, notify the appropriate communications center that the diversion route is no longer needed. 	

Buchanan County Emergency Communications Center	319-334-2597
Inform emergency responders and local municipalities that a diversion route is being implemented. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monitor critical locations. Provide manual traffic control as needed, or as directed by E911 at critical locations. Notify Iowa DOT statewide TMC of any issues along the implemented diversion route. Coordinate with Iowa DOT statewide TMC regarding any maintenance or traffic control needs. 	

Black Hawk County Emergency Communications Center	319-291-2515
Coordinate with the incident commander as to whether a diversion route is needed and which one should be implemented. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Notify Iowa DOT statewide TMC of route implemented, incident specific or maintenance needs, and who the incident commander is. Dispatch County Sheriff, local law enforcement, and fire departments as needed. Inform local municipalities and other jurisdictions that a diversion route is being implemented. Deploy law enforcement to direct traffic at critical locations as needed. Emergency Responders: Secure scene. Provide incident information, diversion route recommendations, and towing needs to E911. Minimize impact to traffic. Provide manual traffic control as needed, or as directed by E911 at critical locations. 	

Iowa DOT Statewide TMC	515-237-3300
Deploy informational DMS and 511 messages to alert motorists of construction, delays, incidents, closures, etc. and/or directional DMS messaging to direct traffic to the implemented diversion route. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monitor incidents and critical locations along the implemented diversion route. Coordinate with Iowa DOT maintenance facilities regarding traffic control needs. Deploy PDMS and Portable CCTV devices as needed for longer duration incidents. Coordinate with local municipalities regarding the modification of signals, signal timing, or stop signs. Coordinate with railroad authority regarding key crossings along the implemented diversion route.
