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RESPONSIBILITIES

<p>Coordinate with the incident commander as to which diversion route should be implemented based on Iowa DOT statewide TMC recommendations.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Notify Iowa DOT statewide TMC of route implemented, incident specific or maintenance needs, and who the incident commander is. Dispatch County Sheriff, local law enforcement, and fire departments as needed. Inform local municipalities and other jurisdictions that a diversion route is being implemented. Deploy law enforcement to direct traffic at critical locations as needed. <p><u>Emergency Responders:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Secure scene. Provide incident information, diversion route recommendations, and towing needs to E911. Minimize impact to traffic. Provide manual traffic control as needed, or as directed by E911 at critical locations

<p>Determine and recommend diversion route to be implemented to county dispatch and state patrol. Deploy informational DMS and 511 messages to alert motorists of construction, delays, incidents, closures, etc. and/or directional DMS messaging to direct traffic to the implemented diversion route.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monitor incidents and critical locations along the implemented diversion route. Coordinate with Iowa DOT maintenance facilities regarding traffic control needs. Deploy PDMS and Portable CCTV devices as needed for longer duration incidents. Coordinate with local municipalities regarding the modification of signals, signal timing, or stop signs. Coordinate with railroad authority regarding key crossings along the implemented diversion route.

<p><u>On-Scene Incident Commander:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Secure scene. Notify appropriate communications center of incident location, anticipated duration, affected lanes, and identify the incident commander. Coordinate with the communications center regarding diversion route needs. Minimize impact to traffic through coordination of on-scene traffic control. Ensure overweight and oversize vehicles are parked. When the incident is safely cleared, notify the appropriate communications center that the diversion route is no longer needed.
